
DOWN:

- 2. THIS BIRDS' WILD LAUGHING CALL GIVES RISE TO THE PHRASE "CRAZY AS A ".
- 3. FLOCKS OF THIS BIRD RUN BUSILY BACK AND FORTH ALONG THE SEASHORE LOOKING FOR FOOD IN THE WATER.





